

Collections of Hadith

There are two kinds of Hadith compilations (collections): *musannaf* and *musnad*. In *musannaf* collections, hadiths are recorded under various headings dealing with juridical subjects. The most famous *musannaf* collections are:

- 1. *Sahih* Al-Bukhari (d. AH 256/870 CE)
- 2. *Sahih* Muslim (d. AH 261/874 CE)
- 3. *Sunan* An-Nasa'i (d. AH 303/916 CE)
- 4. Sunan Abi Dawud (d. AH 275/889 CE)
- 5. *Sunan* At-Tirmidhi (d. AH 279/892 CE)
- 6. Sunan Ibn Majah (d. AH 273/886 CE)

In *musnad* collections, hadiths are arranged alphabetically under the names of the Companions on whose authority these hadiths were reported. An example of this kind is *Musnad* Ahmad ibn Hanbal (d. AH 241/855 CE).
